## **\*\* STUDENT DRESS CODE \*\***

The District's dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, prevent disruption, and minimize safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

Students shall be dressed and groomed in a manner that is clean and neat. Clothing or grooming that in the administrator's judgment may cause disruption, is prohibited.

All students (grades 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>) must wear tennis shoes and appropriate clothing in Physical Education classes.

Pre-K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade students will not be allowed to wear flip-flops or backless shoes for safety reasons. Students in 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> grades must wear shorts underneath dresses.

The district prohibits pictures, emblems, or writings on clothing that are lewd, offensive, vulgar, or obscene, that advertise or depict tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, or any other prohibited substance. Students in grades four through eight may wear shorts, skirts, dresses, culottes, etc., no shorter than 5 inches above the knee when kneeling. Bicycle pants may only be worn under other shorts. Students may not wear any article of clothing that allows their undergarments to be seen. Students may wear tank tops (or similar articles) only if shirts or blouses are worn with them and are properly fitted. Students may not wear any shirts that show any of the midriff section, front or back, with arms raised above their head.

If the administrator determines that a student's grooming violates the dress code, the student shall be given an opportunity to correct the problem at school. A parent may bring a change of clothing to school or an alternative set of clothing will be provided for the day. Second offense – student will be issued a set of clothing for the day and parents will be notified. Third offense – one day in-school-suspension. The dress code is enforced during all school-sponsored activities.

Repeat offenses will result in more serious disciplinary action.
